Punctuality

Attending school is an important part of giving children the best possible start in life. Pupils who miss school frequently can fall behind with their work. It is essential that children are punctual and ready to start the day in an orderly, calm



manner. Lateness impacts on learning, both for the individual, and the class.

Did you know, arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over **3 days lost** each year and arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for **2 weeks a year**.
