

Key Stage 1 Summer Term 2024

PE/GAMES

Tennis, Cricket, Athletics and Swimming

The children will develop their running and jumping techniques with increased speed and height. They will be taught striking and fielding skills such as batting and bowling. In swimming, the children will be taught basic water safety skills and will develop water confidence.



ENGLISH

Fergal is Fuming Zim Zam Zoom

Using dragons and mythical creatures as inspiration, the children will develop their own characters, settings and plots and use these to write their own imaginative stories. We will also read a range of poems and explore alliteration and similes to help the children write their own poems based on the world around them.



HISTORY

Milton Keynes

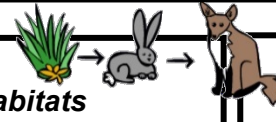
The children will use a range of primary and secondary sources explore how Milton Keynes has developed over time. They will use timelines to order significant events chronologically and identify the impact of these on the local area.



SCIENCE

Living Things and their Habitats

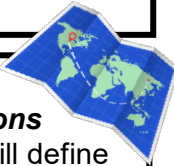
The children will recognise common animals, label their body parts and classify animals into specific groups. They will identify the differences between living things, explore simple food chains and develop their scientific enquiry skills through carrying out a range of investigations.



GEOGRAPHY

Geographical Comparisons

Using a range of sources, we will define and identify physical and human features and then compare the landscapes of England and Australia.

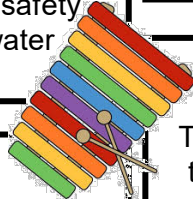


MUSIC

Friendship

Reflect, Rewind and Replay

The children will sing and perform a variety of songs inspired by friendship such as "You've got a friend in me" by Randy Newman. They will create a class composition using a glockenspiel as an accompaniment to their voices.



DT

Making Boats

We will look at the features of boats to help design and build our own using a range of materials. The children will then test their models for buoyancy and strength.



ART

Monochrome Contrasts Joseph Kosuth

We will explore and compare different works of art by Joseph Kosuth before experimenting with tones. The children will use watercolours to create and design their own monochrome art work.



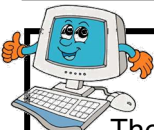
COMPUTING

We are animators

The children will learn how animation works before filming, reviewing and editing their own stop-motion animation.

We are zoologists

The children will collect, record, organise and present data gathered from our environment.



RE

What do people believe about God, people and the natural world?

We will think about the ways in which Christians and other faiths worship and what it means to them. We will also find out what they can learn from religious leaders.



PSHE

Health and Wellbeing

The children will discuss why sleep is important and explore a variety of ways of keeping healthy. They will name different body parts and learn about getting older. The children will look at safety in different environments as well as reacting to emergencies including First Aid.
