

HISTORY Powerful Women

We will be learning about powerful women including Florence
Nightingale and Mary Seacole.
Using a range of sources, the children will explore the inventions and discoveries of these incredible women and identify how their actions impacted on the world.

GEOGRAPHY Our Local Area

The children will identify and name human and physical features in Milton Keynes. They will also compare Bradville with Central Milton Keynes based on their features and describe their findings.

DT Pasta Salad

The children will explore how to make healthy food choices. They will taste a variety of ingredients to help them design, make and evaluate their own pasta salad.

ART

Pablo Picasso - Portraits

Through researching Pablo Picasso the children will explore how he created portraits in the style of 'Cubisim' They will experiment with making different shades of a colour and paint their own monochromatic portraits.

ENGLISH

Little People Big Dreams – Florence Nightingale Tinga Tinga Tales – African Folk Tales

While exploring a range of African folk tales the children will create and describe their own characters using adjectives and go on to write their own short stories. They will identify the features of non-fiction texts and use this knowledge to help them write facts about the life and achievements of Florence Nightingale.

PSHE

Living in the Wider World

The children will explore similarities and differences within a community and learn about the importance of belonging to groups. They will explore how to use the internet safely and about how to look after money.

SCIENCE

Everyday Materials

The children will be learning about different materials and investigating their properties. They will learn how different materials can change shape.

Plants

The children will be taught the functions of parts of plants and learn what their needs are in order to survive. They will investigate germination by growing their own runner bean.

COMPUTING We are Photographers

Using iPads and cameras the children will take their own photographs and use online resources in order to edit and present their images.

We are Safe Researchers

Using the internet safely, the children will search for images and information on a topic which they will present.

PE/GAMES Team Sports

The children will take part in activities designed to improve basic skills and techniques when performing a throwing, dribbling and kicking action. They will participate in team games and learn a simple rules in a range of different sports such as football, unihoc and basketball.

How do Christians and other faiths worship?

The children will explore how Christian beliefs are linked to worship and prayer and compare other faiths.

What do religious people learn from religious leaders?

The children will appreciate why it is necessary to have leaders of religious communities. They will discuss who and why people are important in their lives.
