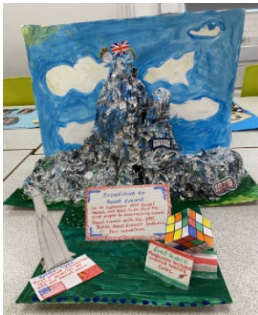




Spring Family Challenge Homework – ‘1975’
